



Getting a Driver's License

Indiana Residents must hold a learner's permit for 180 days before applying for a driver's license and must have completed 50 hours of supervised driving.

How to get a driver's license:

1. Pass a vision screening.
2. Pass a driving test.
3. In some cases, a written test may be required.
4. Pay \$17.50 fee.

Vision Screening:

- Wear glasses or contacts that you normally do.
- Here are two videos on what to expect: you will look into a small machine and read a series of letters that gradually get smaller.

Driving Test:

- Create a myBMV account [here](#).
 - You will need your license number (DLN), the last 4 digits of your social security number, and your zip code.
- Schedule an appointment for taking a driving test using your myBMV account information [here](#).
 - Find BMV locations [here](#).
 - The Speedway location is located at 5620 Crawfordsville Rd.

- Arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled time.
- Review the elements of driving that will be tested.
